FIRST SPORT OF NEW SCHOOL YEAR

- PHYSICALS Print, complete & submit the current PIAA physical form (7 pages on Athletic page of the website under Quick Links Medical Forms), along with St. Luke's HIPPA & Consent to Treat forms (2 pages, same location) to the athletic office by the due date posted on Athletics Eagle Express.
 - Please note physicals may not be dated prior to June 1st of current school year.
- O <u>CONCUSSION TESTING</u> Mandatory for all athletes (grades 7-12) participating in a school sponsored sport.
 - > Testing must be completed every school year, students may not participate without it in any sport.
 - > Concussion testing will be completed at home.
 - ➤ Please note the test **must be taken on a computer** and **NOT ON a PHONE or IPAD**.

- <u>ATHLETIC ACTIVITY FEE</u> athletic fee payment of \$60 must be paid online using the following link:
