

RIGHTS UNDER THE MCKINNEY-VENTO FEDERAL HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT

Students identified as homeless have the following rights:

- Immediate enrollment in a school
- Continue attending their school of origin (if feasible) and the transportation to attend this school
- Assistance in securing necessary immunizations
- Free lunch during school days (and breakfast if available)
- Title I services
- Assistance in securing school supplies and appropriate school clothing

Families/Homeless students have the responsibility to:

- Provide accurate and up-to-date information on housing and residency status to the school.
- Inform the school immediately if the housing/residency status changes.
