Blue Mountain School District Propane Bid Specifications

- 1. The deadline for submission of Propane bids is Thursday, June 19, 2025, at 1:00 PM prevailing time. There will be a public opening of the bids at 1:00 PM on June 19, 2025, in the Conference Room of the Blue Mountain District Office at the address below. The Blue Mountain School District Board of Directors will award the bid at a public meeting on June 26, 2025, at 6:30 PM in the Cafetorium of the Blue Mountain Middle School.
- 2. Supply propane for use at the Blue Mountain Elementary West, Elementary East and Middle School for the 2025 2026 school year. (July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026)
- 3. Supply propane without taxes, due to the Blue Mountain School District's tax-exempt status.
- 4. The propane supplier must indicate the cost of the propane per gallon delivered to the school district.
- 5. The Board of Education retains the right to reject any or all proposals.
- 6. The Blue Mountain School District must have an uninterrupted supply of propane for the Blue Mountain Elementary West, Elementary East and Middle School. The district will provide the supplier with a oneweek advanced notification for the need of a delivery. Delivery will be made to the Blue Mountain Elementary West, 20 N. Front St., Schuylkill Haven, PA, 17972, Blue Mountain Elementary East, 675 Red Dale Rd., Orwigsburg, PA 17961 and Blue Mountain Middle School, 685 Red Dale Rd., Orwigsburg, PA 17961.
- Use the attached bid form to submit your bid in a sealed envelope marked "Propane Bid" and submit to: ATTN: Amy Tomalavage Blue Mountain School District 685 Red Dale Road, P. O. Box 188 Orwigsburg, PA 17961
- 8. The District will only request delivery of Propane from the supplier when there is a need for a minimum of 1,000 gallons. However, the District reserves the right to request a smaller quantity if this is advantageous to the district.
- 9. The District's annual usage of propane ranges from 40,000 gallons to 50,000 gallons depending on weather conditions and the timing of deliveries. Propane will be utilized for heating and hot water at Blue Mountain Elementary West.
- 10. The Blue Mountain Elementary West tank has an 18,000 gallon above-ground tank. The Blue Mountain Elementary East has 2 - 1,000 gallon underground tanks. The Blue Mountain Middle School has 1 – 1,000 gallon underground tank.
- 11. Payment to the supplier by the district will be made at its monthly board meeting from receipt of the invoice.

BID CONDITIONS

- 1. It is mutually understood that the Board has the right to accept or reject all or any portion of any or all bids submitted, and to make the award in the best interest of the Blue Mountain School District.
- 2. The bidder agrees, if awarded the contract, to furnish and deliver the said articles at such times, at such places and in such quantities as herein specified, and that all the articles shall be subject to the inspection and approval of said Board. If any of the said articles shall be rejected as unsuitable or not in conformity with these specifications, such articles shall at once be removed and other articles of proper quality as set forth in these specifications shall be furnished in place thereof at the expense of the successful bidder.
- 3. In the event that the successful bidder shall neglect or refuse to furnish and deliver the said articles or any part thereof as provided in these specifications, or to replace any which are rejected as stated in the preceding paragraph, then, in such event, the Board is authorized and empowered to purchase articles in conformity with this contract, from such party or parties in such quantities and in such manner as it shall select at the expense of the successful bidder, or to cancel this contract reserving to itself, nevertheless, all rights for damages which may be incurred by the Board.
- 4. The bidder agrees that if the contract is awarded to him, he will not assign, transfer or sublet it, unless specific permission to do so is granted in writing, by the Blue Mountain School District.
- 5. The bidder agrees that if the contract is awarded to him, he will not assign in whole or in part any rights or privileges which may accrue to him under the terms of the contract or any money which may become due to him thereunder.
- 6. Where the invitation for bids describes or specifies a particular article, alternate bids covering articles equal in all respects are permitted, unless otherwise stated. Where an invitation specifies an article by name and the bidder intends to furnish another article which he considers equal thereto, in every such instance the manufacturer and model number of the equivalent must be specified in the bid and be accompanied by detailed specifications and drawings or photographs, otherwise no substitution will be allowed.
- 7. The bidder does hereby agree that, if awarded the contract under these specifications, he will indemnify and save harmless the Blue Mountain School District and its Board of School Directors, its members, the Superintendent and his staff, from all suits and actions of every nature and description brought against them or any of them growing out of any contract or contracts, written or verbal, entered into between the Blue Mountain School District and the successful bidder, and further upon the awarding of the contract to the undersigned bidder in accordance with these specifications, this agreement of indemnifications shall automatically become effective.
- 8. Articles as used herein shall include supplies, material and equipment and all incidental work and labor if the same is contemplated in these specifications. Where the term "The Board" is used, it shall be taken to mean the Board of School Directors comprising the Blue Mountain School District or its authorized representatives. The term "furnish" shall mean to furnish at the destination called for.
- 9. All bids must be accompanied by the NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT for such to be considered by the Board.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT

- 1. This Non-Collusion Affidavit is material to any contract awarded pursuant to this bid. According to the Pennsylvania Antibid-Rigging Act, 73 p.s. 1611 <u>et seq</u>, governmental agencies may require Non-Collusion Affidavits to be submitted together with bids.
- 2. This Non-Collusion Affidavit must be executed by the member, officer or employee of the bidder who makes the final decision on prices and the amount quoted in the bid.
- 3. Bid rigging and other efforts to restrain competition, and the making of false sworn statements in connection with the submission of bids are lawful and may be subject to criminal prosecution. The person who signs the Affidavit should examine it carefully before signing and assure himself or herself that each statement is true and accurate, making diligent inquiry, as necessary, of all other persons employed by or associated with the bidder with responsibilities for the preparation, approval or submission of the bid.
- 4. In the case of a bid submitted by a joint venture, each party to the venture must be identified in the bid documents, and an Affidavit must be submitted separately on behalf of each party.
- 5. The term "complementary bid" as used in the Affidavit has the meaning commonly associated with that term in the bidding process and includes the knowing submission of bids higher than the bid of another firm, any intentionally high or noncompetitive bid, and any other form of bid submitted for the purpose of giving a false appearance of competition.
- 6. Failure to file an Affidavit in compliance with these instructions will result in disqualification of the bid.
